

**AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO
H.J.RES 59
OFFERED BY MR. GRAVES OF GEORGIA**

At the end of the matter proposed to be inserted by the Senate amendment (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. 138.

2 (a) DELAY UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2015.—Subject to
3 subsection (c), no provision of the Patient Protection and
4 Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) or title I and
5 subtitle B of title II of the Health Care and Education
6 Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152), or of
7 the amendments made by any such provision, shall have
8 effect until January 1, 2015.

9 (b) LIMITATION ON FEDERAL FUNDING.—Notwith-
10 standing any other provision of law and subject to sub-
11 section (c)—

12 (1) no Federal funds shall be made available
13 before January 1, 2015, to carry out any provision
14 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
15 (Public Law 111-148) or title I and subtitle B of
16 title II of the Health Care and Education Reconcili-
17 ation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-152), or of the

1 amendments made by any such provision and all un-
2 obligated balances available under such provisions
3 are hereby rescinded;

4 (2) any funds made available for fiscal year
5 2014 by this joint resolution or any other Act to
6 carry out any provision of the Patient Protection
7 and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148) or
8 title I or subtitle B of title II of the Health Care
9 and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public
10 Law 111-152), or any amendment made by any such
11 provision, are rescinded; and

12 (3) any funds made so available for fiscal year
13 2015 to carry out any such provision or amendment
14 shall not be available for obligation until January 1,
15 2015.

16 (c) SCHIP EXCEPTION.—Subsections (a) and (b)
17 shall not apply with respect to section 10203 of the Pa-
18 tient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the amend-
19 ments made by such section.
